

Sustainable Water Policy

Swire Pacific recognises that water is essential for life and access to safe water and sanitation is a basic human right. Swire Pacific wants to demonstrate its role as a responsible steward for water by facilitating the sustainable management of water catchments where we source goods, where our factories are located, and where our suppliers and consumers live.

Given the diversity of the Group's business portfolio, implementation of the policy is handled on a company-by-company basis and is overseen by the directors appointed to the company by Swire Pacific; this is a core responsibility of each company's management team.

The executive management of each company in which Swire Pacific has a controlling interest will pay due regard to water management considerations in its operations and supply chain. Associated, jointly controlled and joint venture companies as well as our suppliers are encouraged to follow this policy.

MAKING IT HAPPEN

It is the policy of Swire Pacific to:

- Comply with all water related regulations and integrate industry best practices into operations and services;
- Reduce water consumption in our operations and production processes through annual improvements in our water use efficiency;
- Return 100% of wastewater from our operations to the environment safely;
- In our businesses which consume significant quantities of water, conduct regular water risk assessments
- Where necessary, pursue integrated watershed management;
- As much as possible, replenish water stressed areas with the equivalent amount of water used in our final products which have been made in water stressed areas, through projects such as reforestation, wetland recovery, and improved farming techniques;
- Ensure the availability and transparency of water data for setting, monitoring and regularly reviewing water withdrawal intensity objectives and targets;
- Ensuring appropriate access to safe and potable water, sanitation and hygiene for all employees at worksites under Swire Pacific's control;

- Protect salt or freshwater ecosystems at our sites or from which we extract water, from over extraction or contamination because of our activities;
- Partnering to help provide community access to safe and potable water;
- Extending water conservation to our first-tier supply chain, by equipping suppliers with tools to protect water resources in water stressed areas;
- Stewarding public water advocacy and engagement.

Swire Pacific will review this sustainable water policy from time to time as appropriate and, in any event, once every three years.
